1. PHILANTHROPY

Our philanthropic contributions in 2024 have focused on amplifying community impact and advancing sustainable, inclusive development.

a. Grant AdministrationSupport

Soristic supports the Grant Administration of a Fund in Singapore that aims to help communities uplift the vulnerable and foster an environment of care through ground-up, self-help philanthropic initiatives by citizens and residents.

We guided than 60 more changemakers, ground-up initiatives, and newly established non-profits through the grant application process. Their projects brought fresh, impactful solutions to wide range including communities. vulnerable children, seniors and migrant workers in Singapore.



Our support began well before the application stage, with monthly information sessions that introduced potential grantees to the Fund and helped them shape their project ideas. As they progressed through the application process, we provided tailored guidance to strengthen their proposals.

Beyond the application phase, we delivered targeted capacity-building workshops on key topics to enhance their skills and confidence.

It's been deeply rewarding to see these changemakers create lasting impact in their communities and to watch their efforts inspire others to take action.



b. Due Diligence

Soristic conducted impact due diligence across diverse causes such as conservation, education, biodiversity and poverty alleviation. Beyond evaluating organisations, we support a more coordinated, informed philanthropic ecosystem.

Project Geography:



Some due diligence projects Soristic conducted in 2024:

- A conservation initiative aimed at protecting wetland biodiversity in Cambodia to enhance the livelihoods of local farming communities.
- A project to strengthen nationwide literacy in India.
- An initiative monitoring seafloor ecosystems to support marine conservation.

We assessed each project based on governance, impact potential, scalability, financial sustainability and key risks, ensuring they were both credible and positioned to drive meaningful change. To strengthen our evaluations, we engaged key experts across various causes, grounding our insights in sector-specific knowledge. These structured assessments helped guide philanthropic capital toward solutions with the potential to address systemic gaps in the region.



2. KNOWLEDGE

We shared knowledge primarily through research and impact assessments. By generating insights, we enabled stakeholders to allocate resources more strategically , contributing to broader efforts to reduce inequality in society.

a. Research

Besides customised research for our clients, we published our flagship report, **Singapore's Biggest Philanthropic Organisations (Third Edition).** The report identifies and ranks private philanthropic funders by annual grant disbursement. The 2024 edition featured 117 organisations giving S\$431 million — a 96% increase from the previous edition. Widely cited by media, the report is also purchased by many charities seeking deeper insight into the funding landscape.

b. Outcomes Measurement Framework

Soristic developed a customised outcome measurement framework for a client funding regional charities. Aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the framework was co-created through a consultative process with partner organisations. It accommodates diverse reporting systems and capacities, enabling scalable and aggregated outcome reporting.



c. Impact Assessments

Soristic evaluated programmes aimed at reducing inequality by generating insights to strengthen support for vulnerable groups in Singapore. For example, our assessment of a matched savings programme provided findings that could inform improvements in financial support for low-income families. Likewise, our evaluation of a dementia care initiative offered recommendations to enhance engagement strategies in nursing homes and improve well-being outcomes for seniors.

d. Ecosystem Mapping

In 2024, Soristic supported the newly established Benjamin Wong Foundation that is focused on animal welfare, through ecosystem mapping and a needs assessment. We engaged key stakeholders across the sector, including government agencies, educational institutions and individual feeders and identified opportunities and potential partners to address critical gaps.





Soristic's research into the dog ecosystem of Singapore and vet careers in Asia has set up The Benjamin Wong Foundation for possibly decades to come, culminating with The Dog Pad rehab facility opening in 2025 and the sponsorship of a growing number of students.

Soristic also helped us connect the dots and develop strategies. Their research gave us essential information to fully understand the heart of the challenges and gain the respect of those we met through Soristic's extensive network. The team's dedication gave us the solid insights we needed to shape The Benjamin Wong Foundation's future to a scale we would not have achieved alone.

Long may this partnership continue. We cannot recommend the work of Soristic enough.



3. CAPACITY BUILDING

In 2024, Soristic continued to invest in capacity building initiatives, focusing on both youth and social sector professionals. These efforts played a key role in bridging capability and awareness gaps, contributing to systemic efforts to reduce inequality.

a. Workshops

In 2024, our workshops had reached impressive numbers:



i. Social Sector

As trends in the social sector continue to evolve, we have adapted our capacity building efforts to stay relevant.

For instance, to meet sector needs and complement the launch of Singapore's Biggest Philanthropic Organisations (Third Edition), we conducted **Elevating Philanthropy 2.0**, a workshop where industry experts shared effective strategies to enhance fundraising efforts.

In response to the fundraising challenges and uncertainty faced by many charities and non-profits, the workshop was designed to offer practical solutions while addressing broader sector-wide concerns.

We also launched our Pathways to Non-Profit Success programme, partnering with experienced practitioners to deliver targeted courses that build capacity among social sector professionals.

ii. Youth

Our youth initiatives focused on building empathy and raising awareness of social issues. Through a series of experiential booths, secondary school students engaged in simulations of disabilities visual such as hearing loss and impairment. We also launched a youth leadership training programme aimed at fostering intergenerational and intercultural understanding.

Our youth leadership programme empowered student leaders from 12 schools with the skills and knowledge to launch their own campaigns promoting inclusivity among their peers.

b. Human Libraries

In 2024, Soristic hosted Human Library events that fostered honest dialogue on topics like migrant worker experiences and intergenerational understanding. These reduce sessions aimed to inequality by sharing real-life stories from overlooked communities, helping participants build and empathy connection across differences.
